

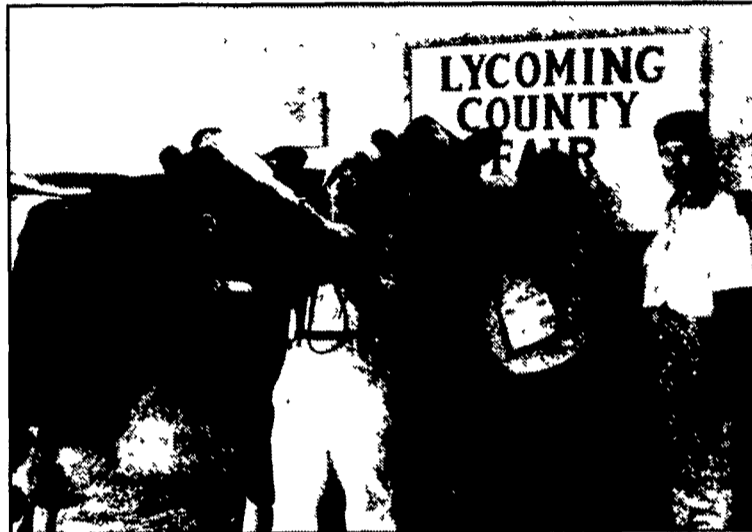
Lycoming County Holstein Show

Manheim FFA Member Wins Trip To Nashville
Troy Wenger, Manheim FFA member, was one of four Lancaster County FFA members to be selected to attend the Pennsylvania Council of Agriculture Cooperatives Summer Institute (PCC).

Troy spent four days at Shippensburg University learning how to run a business in the form of a cooperative. Emphasis was placed on leadership development and skills necessary to operate a business.

Activities during the week included forming a cooperative and selling its products to other students, leading general sessions, Variety Show, Viewpoint-public speaking about agriculture topics, daily newspaper,

News Team, chorus, and a cooperative poster contest. Adult resource leaders for the week included cooperative employees from across Pennsylvania, agriculture teachers, and Penn State Cooperative Education staff.

Troy's involvement in many of the PCC activities and his family's dairy farm commitment to marketing their milk through Land O Lakes Cooperative earned him a trip to the National Institute of Cooperative Education (NICE) in Nashville, Tenn. Troy was one of only 13 students selected to attend NICE. Students from across the U.S. meet to learn about the business of cooperatives. Tours of agriculture sites in the Nashville area were conducted.

Manheim FFA Triumphs In State Competition
Fifteen Manheim FFA members competed in eight different Career Development Events (CDE) June 13-15 at Pennsylvania FFA Activities Week in State College.

They were among 1,500 top agriculture students from across Pennsylvania to compete at this annual event. The Pennsylvania FFA Foundation provides the funding for the award winners.
