considering many feeders are cleaning out their barns to start fresh. Prices for Virginia feeder cattle have eased up over the last several weeks and 800 lb black feeder steers can now be purchased for under 80.00 cwt. However, the local demand for replacement feeders will soon skyrocket as farmers finish filling

their silos and become anxious to feed this years abundant crop. Western fat cattle prices were steady to .50 higher this week, trading from 65.00-65.50 live and mostly 103.00 dressed. Local Holstein steers closed steady to .50 lower Slaughter cow trading was active and prices ended 1.00-2.00 higher, while slaughter bulls finished mostly 1 00 lower.

Supply included 40 percent slaughter steers, 7 percent slaughter heifers, 40 percent cows, 6 percent bulls with the balance feeders.




