## Cambria County Conducts 4-H Sale

EBENSBURG (Cambria Co.) — The Cambria County 4-H Livestock Sale was conducted Thursday, Sept. 7 at the Cambria County Fairgrounds. One hundred ninety-six 4-H animals were sold, grossing \$102,203.23. The sale, which lasted nearly four and half hours, brought buyers from Cambria and neighboring counties which supported local 4-H'ers. The livestock auction was composed of 112 market hogs

which averaged \$1.36 per pound, 16 meat pen rabbits which averaged \$13.09 per pound, 23 market lambs which averaged \$1.26 per pound, five market goats which averaged \$1.50 per pound, 15 veal calves which averaged \$1.07 per pound, and 24 steers which averaged \$1.01 per pound. The grand champion market hog exhibited by Michael Weyant of Windber started the livestock auction. Weyant received a bid of \$2.95 per pound from Dr. Kerry Kirsch for his

prize-winning animal. Megan Skebeck of Patton paraded her reserve hog through the sale ring with the winning bid of \$2.40 per pound to Agway Energy Products. Scott Strittmatter of Ebensburg paraded his grand champion market lamb through the auction block with the winning bid of \$3.30 per pound from Direct Value Outlet. The reserve exhibited by Jamie Johns of Johnstown was also purchased by Direct Value

Outlet for a price of \$2 per pound. Long Hardwoods paid a premium price of \$2.85 per pound purchasing the grand champion market goat, exhibited by Karen McMullen of Ashville. Clairissa Myers of Ashville presented her reserve goat to the buyers before receiving a bid of \$1.35 per pound from Long Barn, Inc. Blarney Stone Personal Care purchased the grand champion veal of Kelly Myers of South Fork for \$1.10 per pound. The reserve of Krystal Heinlein of


Summerhill topped the veal with a bid of \$2 per pound from Alex Froehlich Packing Co. Andy Myers of South Fork received a bid of \$2.95 per pound from Hoss's Steak and Sea House on the grand champion market steer. Hoss's then donated the champion back for resale with proceeds going to the 4-H scholarship fund. Alex Froehlich Packing Company purchased the animal through the resale. The reserve exhibited by Kelly Myers of South Fork was awarded a bid of \$1.20 per pound from Kosta's Restaurant.


