Perhaps the best demand came late in the sale, but prices never wavered much through the entire offering. Holstein steer prices were steady to .50 lower. Slaughter cows sold fully .50 higher, but slaughter bulls traded 1.00 lower. Supply included 44 percent slaughter steers and 35 percent slaughter cows.
