most popular events is the "Challenge of the Breeds," which will attract participants from 10 breeds competing for a \$1,000 first-place award.

In the sheep department, the exposition will feature three regional shows in the junior division: the Eastern Regional Dorset Junior Show, the Mid-Eastern Regional Tunis Youth Show, and the Regional Montadale Junior Show. In addition to these events, seven breeds will conduct ewe sales during the exposition.

Starting on Thursday, at 4 p.m., will be the Stockmen's Trade Show. Everything from T-shirts and jewelry to saddles and horse trailers will be available to purchase from the vendor booths at the show.

Hundreds of collegiate, FFA, and 4-H students from several

states always enter the junior livestock judging and stockman contests at KILE. These keen educational competitions are excellent tests of knowledge and skill, providing students with valuable experience for their futures in agriculture.

More than 4,100 entries are expected for the 2000 show, which offers a record \$200,000 in premiums.

A tantalizing assortment of foods prepared by various Pennsylvania commodity groups will be available and the Barnyard Baby Exhibit, where young and old alike may touch and pet the animals, is always a favorite spot at the show.
