CATTLE. Compared to last week's closing prices, slaughter steers and heifers sold firm. The market never strayed very far from steady, but more of the trading occurred at the top of the price range than last week. The quality of this week's offering was surprisingly high, considering many feeders are cleaning out their barns to start fresh. Prices for Virginia feeder cattle have eased up over the last several weeks and 800 lb black feeder steers can now be purchased for under 80.00 cwt. However, the local demand for replacement feeders will soon skyrocket as farmers finish filling their silos and become anxious to feed this years abundant crop. Western fat cattle prices were steady to .50 higher this week, trading from 65.00-65.50 live and mostly 103.00 dressed. Local Holstein steers closed steady to .50 lower. Slaughter cow trading was active and prices ended 1.00-2.00 higher, while slaughter bulls finished mostly 1.00 lower. Farewell, it has been my pleasure to report this market. Supply included 40 percent slaughter steers, 7 percent slaughter heifers, 40 percent cows, 6 percent bulls with the balance feeders.


CALVES: Compared to last week, lightweight vealers closed steady to 5.00 lower. Slaughter calves ended mostly steady, after trading sharply higher earlier in the week Holstein bull calves headed for special-fed veal barns sold progressively higher through the week, closing steady to 5.00 higher. Holstein heifer trading was uneven with improved demand for weights under 80 lbs, but buyers were more selective as to quality on the average weight heifer calves. Prices closed unevenly steady to as much as 50.00 higher.


