

DERSTLER SALE

Horst Auction Center, Ephrata, hosted a sale of tools, primitives, antiques and tool reference books on Saturday. There were 220 registered bidders at the auc-tion, held for Hazel Derstler, Columbia.

Mrs. Derstler's late husband, Harry, collected tools, many made by local craftsmen. Items sold included a plow plane made by E.W. Carpenter, \$1,000; a pat-ented metal brace by Darling of Bridgewater, Mass., 4900; a 15 piece carving chisel set, \$260; three marking gauges by J. Stamm, \$190,0 and \$230; a marking gauge by E.W. Carpenter, \$150; tinner's hammer by J. Will, \$150; and an iron level by Davis, \$270.

Additional tools sold included an early handwrought breast brace, \$300; an adze by D. 


ESTATE SALE A Public Sale of real estate was held September 23 for the estate of Charlotte M. Ritter, Richfield, Snyder County, Pa.


