Barner's Church Prepares Apple Butter Boil

LIVERPOOL (Perry Co.) -As the leaves start to turn colors and the air turns cool, a small country church starts to prepare for their annual Apple Butter Boil. About 40 miles up the Susquehanna River from Harrisburg, and just a few miles back in the hills from the tiny riverside town of Liverpool, sits a red brick church known as St. John's (Barner's) Lutheran Church. On Oct. 14, the Church will hold their 49th annual Apple Butter Boil.

In the weeks prior to this event, much preparation is needed. There is planning and ordering and advertising. There is wood to be gotten for the boiling of the apple butter, all foods

are prepared, snitzing (paring and coring of apples for the apple butter) by many in the community, and much other work detail.

As many sleep through the midnight hours, the men will be putting on the freshly pressed cider to boil it down over the open fires. As dawn breaks through the night sky, the first bucket of snitz (sliced apples) is added to the boiled-down cider. By the time the first kettle is ready, the church grove is buzzing with activity. The women gather to prepare the meals and set up the craft table. By 9:30 a.m., all is ready for the people who make the annual pilgrimage to this 200-year-old church for a day of fellowship, fun, and histo-

The event includes apple butter boiling, a craft table, a concession stand, and a Dutch dinner of Bott-Boi (pot pie) with all the trimmings. The apple butter is boiled in antique copper kettles and is for sale on the grounds.

Bring your own jars. The craft table is set up in the church grove. Many members donate items for sale that demonstrate their talents.

The concession stand sells homemade chicken corn soup, homemade ham and bean soup, bar-be-cue sandwiches, hot dogs, homemade pies and ice cream, and the famous hot apple butter sundaes. The highlight of the day is the Dutch dinner, which includes chicken or beef pot pie, corn, peas, red beets, pickles, coleslaw, freshly made apple butter, schmier-kase, and homestyle

If you want to make the pilgrimage to the little red brick church that's perched atop a hill in Perry County, the directions are simple. Take Routes 11 and 15 to Liverpool, Pa. Turn left onto Route 17. About one mile from Liverpool, turn right onto Route 235. Follow the apple butter signs to the Church on the hill. Come and enjoy how our ancestors boiled apple butter.


