

Power, Eye Appeal Mark KILE Angus Show Animals

HARRISBURG (Dauphin Co.) — Although the heifers shown at the recent Keystone International Livestock Exposition (KILE) at the Farm Show Complex proved to be a hard act to follow, quality bulls provided an equally impressive show.

"This is as good a lineup as we've ever seen," said Angus show judge Tim Fitzgerald of the heifer show. "This lineup is extremely stout and powerful in its makings. It could run with any competition in the country today."

Fitzgerald had the opportunity to view the classes from another side of the fence this year, as he has shown at KILE competition in past years. This year, however, marked the first year to judge the event.

A July heifer, "Champion Hill Georgina 1693 13464473," owned by Ed and Mandy Richardson, Louisa, Va., took home grand champion female honors. (S: Leachman Saugahatchee 3000D; D: LLA Georgi)

"This heifer is extremely well-made. She's deep in the forerib and flank, is sound on her feet and legs, and has a smooth front end," said Fitzgerald.

Reserve grand champion female went home with Clark Farm's, Hustontown, "SRS Lucy's Quality 8110 13568061."

According to Fitzgerald the quality was equally as good in the Angus bull show. "These bulls are sound, have extra bone, have the stoutness and power in the way they move. When you go home and turn them out they'll stay sound for the rest of their lives. There will be good breeding days ahead for these bulls. They've got balance and eye appeal," said Fitzgerald.

Grand champion bull went to Weaverland Valley Farms and Harry Bachman. "WVF HB Atlantic National Merit +13521388," (S: LF New Trend 4100; D: LLA Georgina 419) took top placing as a bull that is "Not only sound and thick, but he's got a great top and hip. He stand stout with the smoothness and length of body," said Fitzgerald.

Reserve grand champion bull, 2-year-old "Meadow Mist 033 30811 13005070," was owned by

by Burleigh Anderson and JDH Cattle Company, Dover. "He's powerful, thick-ended, with a long body, and he'll stay sound," said Fitzgerald.

Fitzgerald is the manager of Fox Cross Angus Ranch in Alderson, W. Va. Fitzgerald attended Oklahoma State University and has a bachelor's degree in animal science and business.

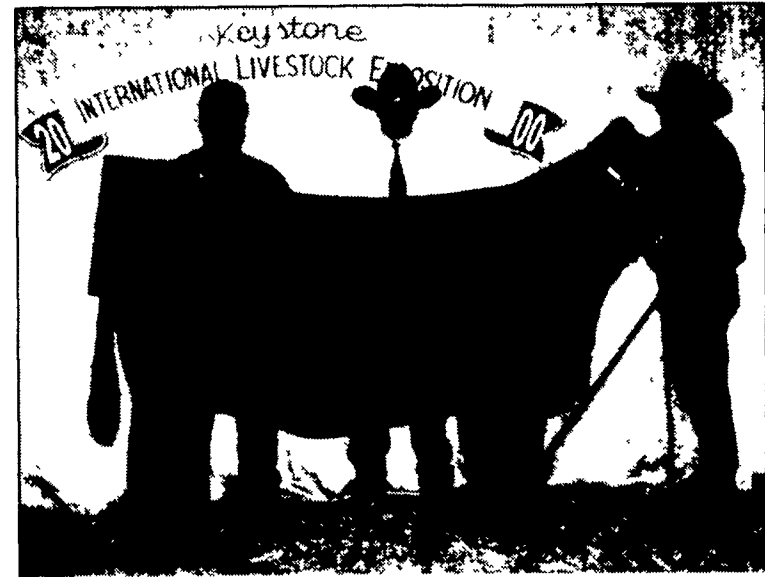

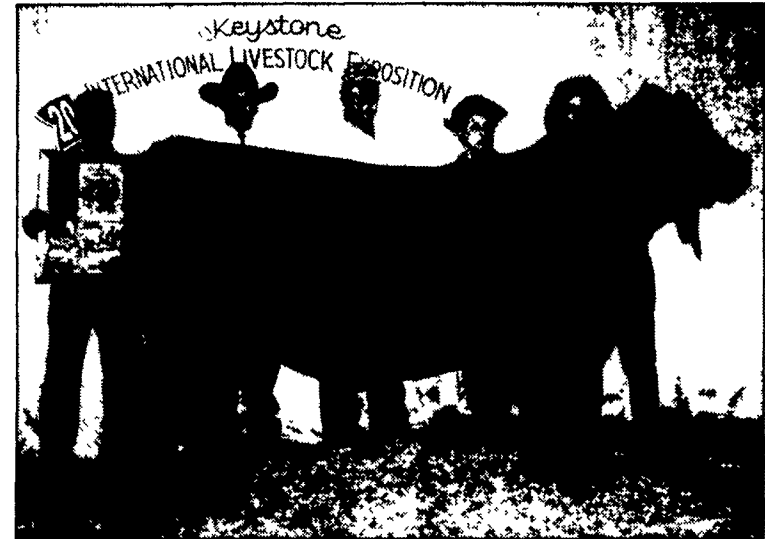
