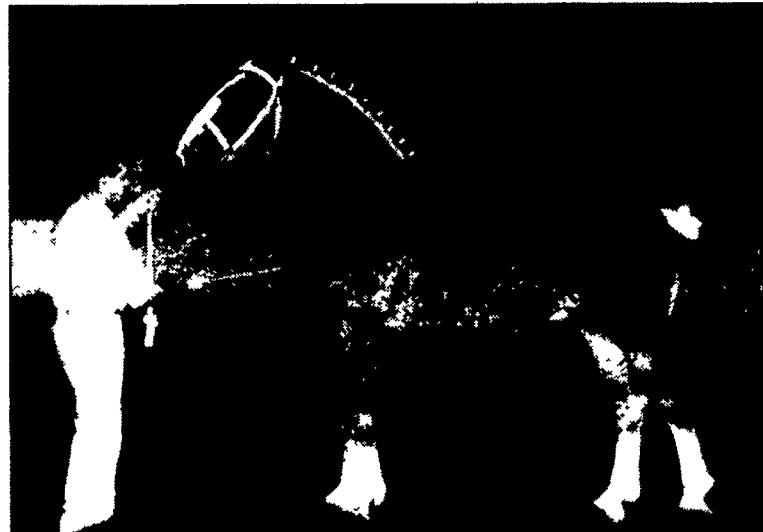

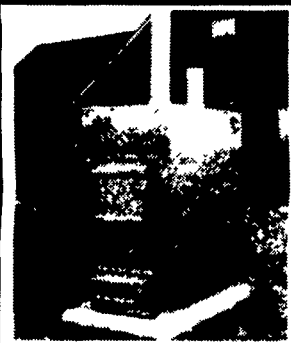


2000 Belgian show grand champion mare, P.V.F. Barb Supreme, Darrell Drain, Ontario, Canada.
