Clues: Some descriptions of decorative techniques are:

- Marquetry a veneer of a complex, usually pictorial motif. Often using various woods.
- Parquetry simple, geometric marquetry of one or several kinds of wood.
- Pietre Dure decorative panels of semi-precious stones and marbles.
- Niello a way of decorating metal with a black inlay by fusing an alloy of various metals into an engraved design.
- Oyster Shell Veneer wooden veneer cut from small branches of trees like laburnum, so that each separate veneer resembles an oyster shell.


