Hoffman Elected Chairman

NORCROSS, Ga. — C. Steve Hoffman, president, IMC International and senior vice president of IMC Global, Inc., was elected chairman of the Potash and Phosphate Institute (PPI) board of directors at a recent meeting.

He will also serve as Chairman of the Foundation for Agronomic Research (FAR) Board of Directors for the coming year.

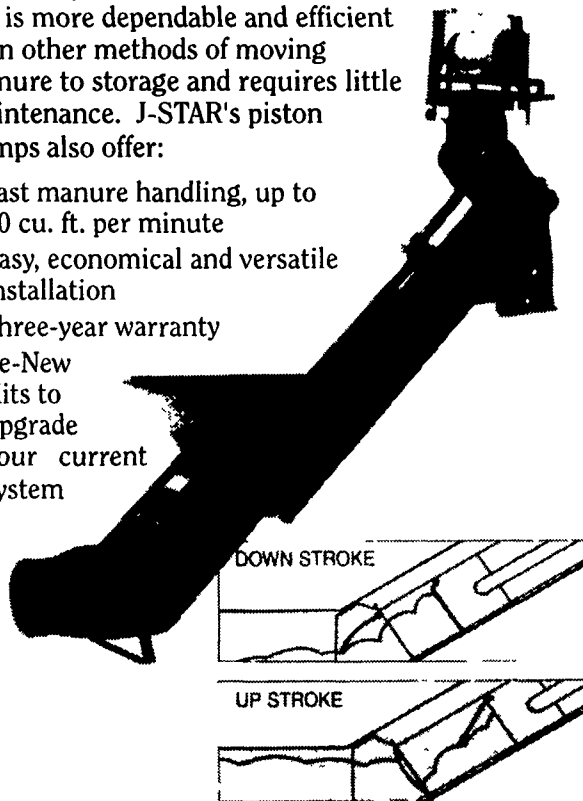
