According to auctioneer Randal Kline, the Weaver family owned the farm, at 380 Linden Road, East Earl, for well over a century. William G. Weaver was born there, Kline said, and he recently died at the age of 97. The sale of the farm attracted a crowd of between 450 and 500 people, he said.
