What You Need

## /hat You Do

# **Pillows**

What You Need: **Felt Squares** Scissors Pillow Stuffing Fabric Glue

Decorations-beads, buttons, sequins, etc.

## What You Do

Select the colors of felt for your pillow. From one piece of felt, cut out the design-animal, Christmas tree, flower, etc.—you want for the front of the pillow You may want to use cookie cutters or pictures from magazines as patterns Glue the design on the piece of felt that will be the pillow front. Put glue around three edges of the back of the pillow front Attach another piece of felt to the back of the first piece. Stuff the pillow through the opening, then run glue around the open edge and close it. Apply decorations to the design on the front of the pillow These pillows will make fun gifts for anyone
