Daily National Grain Market Summary Wheat and corn bids closed mostly mixed with soybeans slightly lower. Wheat steady to 1 cent lower. Corn bids mixed 2 cents lower to 3 cents higher. Sorghum 1 cent lower Soybeans 3 to 4 cents lower.

Wheat bids finished slightly lower due to beneficial snow cover over winter wheat growing areas. Lack of fresh

export news for wheat added weakness. Corn bids mostly lower due to some profit taking on the Board. Soybeans bids were pressured by favorable weather reports in Brazil's main soybean belts and rains forecast for Argentina. Overnight export bean sales limited declines.
