CONRAD WEISER DOCUMENT BRINGS \$1,100

An auction of books, newspapers and manuscripts was held Dec. 15 and Dec. 16, at Horst Auction Center, Ephrata. The auction was cataloged by Clarence E. Spohn.

There were 219 registered bidders.

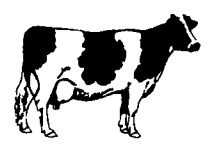
