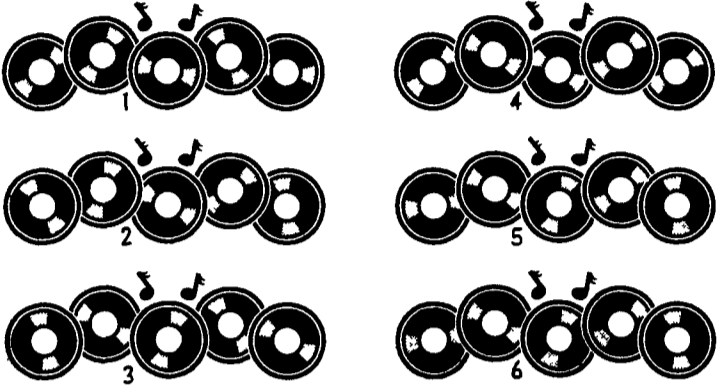

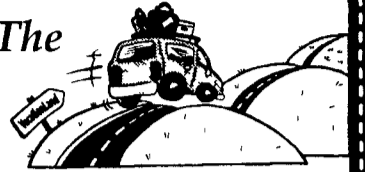
Saying—

Thank You

- Use holiday thank you cards or postcards. You can buy or make them.
- One way to make thank-you cards or notes is by using old holiday cards. Cut pictures from the front of cards and paste them on plain paper. Write your thank you note, fold it and mail it in an envelope.
- Make a list of everyone who gave you a gift. Be sure to list what gift(s) you received beside each of the names.
- Add something about the gift. For instance, if someone gave you money, tell how you plan to spend it.
- Don't be dishonest about your gift, but think about the positives of it. If your aunt gave you socks instead of a toy, tell her how you can really use the socks.
- Add something about your holiday. For instance, tell where you ate Christmas dinner or how you and your cousins played the dreidel game.

Want a great idea on how to spend a weekend? How about taking a short trip that would be fun for the whole family?

Lost World Caverns, Lewisburg, West Virginia
Go 100 feet below the earth's surface to see the beautiful rock formations in the Lost World Caverns. In the early 1960s, explorers examined more than a mile of passages that reached a depth of 235 feet below the natural entrance of the cave.

The caverns' highlights include Goliath, a 40 foot tall and 25 foot wide column, and Snow Chandelier, a huge piece of rock that looks like an icicle and is estimated to weigh 30 tons. Buffalo Bill Historical Center, Cody, Wyoming
The center is made up of a library and four museums—Whitney Gallery of Western Art, Buffalo Bill Museum, Plains Indian Museum and Cody Firearms Museum.

Bluebonnet Swamp, Baton Rouge, Louisiana
The Bluebonnet Swamp Nature Center includes Louisiana's largest duck hunting decoy collection and other exhibits. Outside the center, you'll find 65 acres to explore. The swamp is home to birds, foxes, bobcats, snakes and alligators.

Hawaii Volcanoes National Park, Island of Hawaii
The park is 230,000 acres in size and has hiking, exploring and educational opportunities. One feature of the park is Mauna Loa, the world's biggest volcano. With two live volcanoes, conditions can change fast, so stay alert and stop by the Kilauea Visitor Center first.

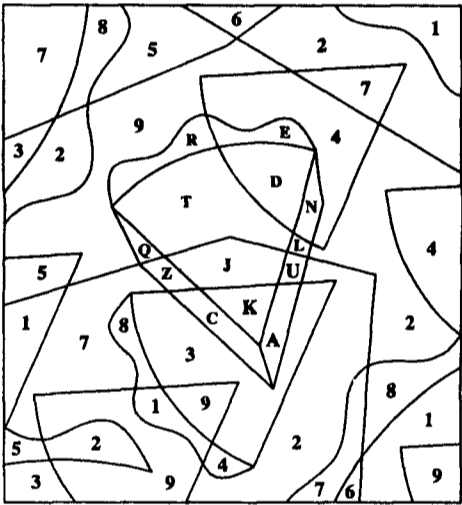

Circus World Museum, Baraboo, Wisconsin
Rare circus posters, circus wagons, floats and colorful circus costumes are all on display at the Circus World Museum.

From early November to early May, the museum is open 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday to Saturday and 11 a.m. to 4 p.m. Sunday. It is closed major holidays. 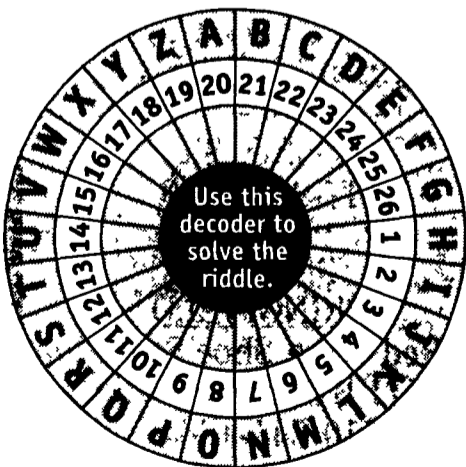

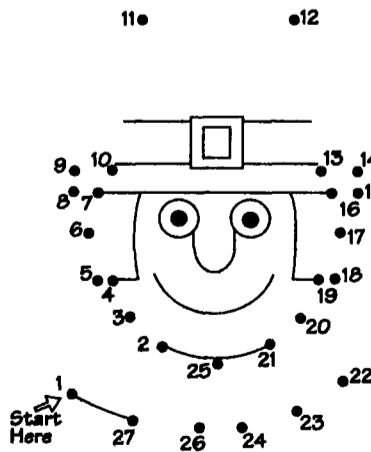
