**Producers,
Importers
Must
Continue To
Pay Pork
Checkoff
Assessment**

WASHINGTON, D.C. — On Jan. 19, the U.S. District Court for Western Michigan, Grand Rapids, Mich., granted the National Pork Producers Council and other plaintiffs a temporary restraining order prohibiting the U.S. Department of Agriculture from publishing a rule to end the pork checkoff program based on a referendum August-September 2000.

In accordance with this court order, the Pork Promotion, Research, and Consumer Information Order is still in effect and pork producers and importers must continue to pay pork checkoff assessments. Failure to pay the assessment will be subject to a fine of up to \$1,100 per violation.
