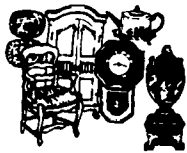

SNEATH AND BRENNER SALE

A sale of antiques, collectibles, household goods, tools and a car was held Wednesday for June M. Sneath, J. Fred Brenner and others. There were 440 registered bidders.

Among items sold were: a 1989 Chevrolet Corsica 4-door sedan, \$950; a Japanese sword, \$1,100; a Redware wig stand, \$230; an Uncle Sam bank, \$110; a table lamp, \$180; a banquet lamp, \$175; Royal Doulton baseball player, \$130; two braided throw rugs, \$140; a braided rug, \$100; an oak shelf clock, \$120; a flint glass lamp, \$100; a quilt, \$125; a flower garden quilt, \$100, a spatula and fork, \$140; a wallpaper box, \$425; a Treen egg cup, \$100, a blue check, \$125; a large check fabric, \$165; a woolen coverlet, \$170; a crazy patch quilt, \$180; lot of cards, \$150; 1982 and 1983 wooden Anri plates, \$145; 1988, 1989 and 1990 wooden Anri plates, \$115; a uniform, \$110; a leaded glass window, \$100; and a waterfall bedroom set, \$100.

\$350; a cottage washstand, \$120; a redecorated chest, \$150; a sofa table, \$105; a round lampstand, \$150; a jelly cupboard, \$290; a four-drawer spool cabinet, \$350; a buffet mirror, \$125; a set of Empire side chairs, \$140; a green runner, \$200; a mahogany gateleg table, \$130; a Governor Winthrop desk, \$130; a cottage-style dresser, \$150; a round patio set, \$155; a three-piece patio set, \$195; a blanket chest, \$190; six oak chairs, \$260; a grain decorated blanket chest, \$185; a dropfront desk, \$375; a mahogany high chest, \$190; an Empire bureau, \$150; a GE washer, \$120; a Hotpoint dryer, \$160; Toro snow blower, \$375.

The auction was held by Horst Auctioneers at Horst Auction Center, Ephrata.

BUCHART AND MUSSELMAN SALE

In an auction filled with valuable made-in-Lancaster-County items, one piece stood out: a late 18th-century Dutch cupboard which sold for \$100,000 on Saturday at Horst Auctioneers in Ephrata. The painted Chippendale step-back cupboard was "probably the finest Dutch cupboard we've ever handled," said cataloger Clarence E. Spohn.

The cupboard was sold to antique dealer Phillip Bradley, Chester County. The previous owner, Mary S. Buchart of York, acquired the piece around 1950 from dealer Forest McMullen, who operated an Ephrata antiques show in the 1960s and '70s, Spohn said.

Also sold were Lehnware items made by Joseph Long Lehn of Elizabeth Township in the 19th century, including a water bucket for \$22,000. The Lehnware was from the collection of Sara B. Musselman of Murrell, near Ephrata.

Another highlight of the sale was Walter Steely's mid-20th century chairs. Steely was a Lititz resident.

In all, more than 500 lots of antique furniture, china, glass, silver, Lehnware, pottery and primitives were sold. There were 400 registered bidders at the sale, which also included items from the collection of Robert G. Grunder, Trumansburg, N.Y.

In addition to the water bucket, the following Lehnware items were sold: two cup and saucer sets, \$2,600 each; a covered saffron cup, \$2,000; two sugar buckets, \$10,000 and \$2,100; an individual salt, \$2,200; a sewing box, \$2,900; and three master salts, \$2,400, \$2,800 and \$4,700; and two miniature blanket chests, \$8,000 and \$2,500.

The Steely items sold included a set of four signed side chairs, \$2,400; a writing chair, \$2,200; a pair of sack-back arm chairs, \$1,650; a set of six Windsor side chairs, \$3,300; a bamboo-style arm chair, \$900; and a comb-back arm chair, \$1,550.

Other items sold included a Chippendale maple slant-front desk,

\$2,900; a softwood stretcher-base farm table, \$3,500; an oak joined bench, \$2,800; a Sheraton mahogany dressing table, \$2,300; a softwood stretcher-base sawbuck table, \$1,000; a wrought iron strongbox, \$1,250; a ladder-back side chair, \$1,450; a Federal era slant front desk, \$4,400; a walnut candlestand, \$625; a softwood bucket bench, \$1,550; a two-drawer mahogany lampstand, \$1,950; and a Queen Anne side chair, \$950.

Also sold were a Victorian four-piece parlor set, \$1,150; a Sheraton tiger maple one-drawer stand, \$800; a two-piece red painted corner cupboard, \$9,000; a set of six Windsor-style side chairs, \$1,350; a walnut secretary desk, \$1,250; a modern tallcase clock, \$1,300; an antique tallcase clock, \$1,400; a shelf clock, \$1,000; and an eight-day banjo clock, \$1,300.

Also sold were an electric barber's sign, \$1,100; a folk art 1818 memorial picture, \$1,050; and a folk art watercolor painting of a girl, \$1,550; a room-sized hooked rug, \$1,750; a signed John Bell flower pot, \$575; a John Bell stoneware decorated crock, \$1,250; a John Bell Redware tub, \$1,100; a sapphire and pearl necklace, \$900; a 1735 wine bottle, \$1,800; a Mocha Seaweed pattern mug, \$825; and a Rose Medallion coffee pot, \$650.
