Quality was mostly average, with a few attractive lots on offer. Receipts were reduced due to heavy snow across the state. Slaughter heifers, holsteins, and bulls not well tested. Slaughter cows traded firm to 1.00 higher. Supply included 35 percent slaughter steers and 55 percent cows.

SLAUGHTER STEERS: High Choice and Prime 2-4 1230-1485 lbs 78.60-80.75, with fancy singles up to 83.00. Choice 2-3 1135-1475 lbs 76.00-79.50, with high dressing 1-2 up to 81.75; 1510-1550 lbs 74.50-79.50. Select and low Choice 2-3 few 1050-1430 lb 72.00-76.25.

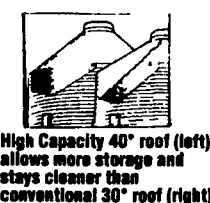
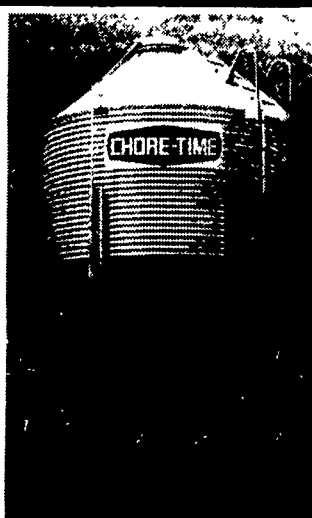

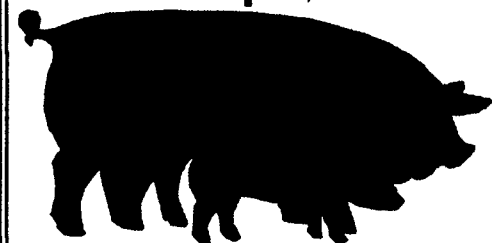
