time to visit with industry representatives from all facets of the dairy industry, as well as other farmers. This year's pie auction averaged \$50 per pie with Joyce Taylor's winning confection bringing a price of \$150 from Morressey Insurance.

Nineteen pies were judged, raising \$995, which will be shared between the 4-H dairy

program and the dairy princess program, less \$100 in prize money for the entrants.

"We've got a lot more life in Dairy Day," noted Hennip. "It's
