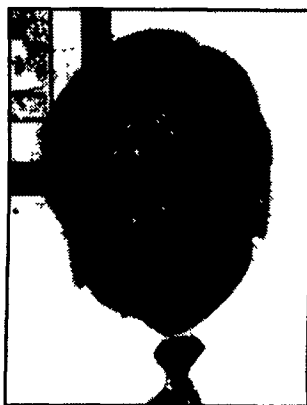

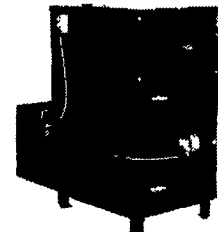


Tobacco Auction No More

QUARRYVILLE (Lancaster Co.) — It was reported in county newspapers this week that the Pennsylvania Tobacco Marketing Association Auction is being phased out.

Auction Manager Dennis Hess noted the association will be working on a newsletter to send out to members to notify them of the closing. The association will not officially dissolve, according to Hess, until all tobacco grown by its members in the past three years has been sold.
