Offerings ranged adequate to ample and were more readily available on the 3.5 and 4.0 pound sizes which were competitively priced and slow in clearing. Live supplies were at least moderate; weights were mostly desirable to heavy. Processing schedules were moderately heavy. Less than trucklot asking prices were unchanged at 54 to 68 cents.
