nobert Lee Frost, born on March 26, 1874, was not a man of few words. Nevertheless, the four-time man of few words. Reversing poet could be concise: "In Pulitzer Prize winning poet could be concise: "In three words I can sum up everything I've learned about life." he told us. "It goes on." As the unofficial poet laureate of the United States, the aged Frost was invited to speak at John F. Kennedy's mauguration in 1961.

He composed a special poem for the occasion, which spoke of "A golden age of poetry and power Of which this noonday's the beginning hour." His

age also gave him perspective, it seemed. "Why abandon a belief merely because it ceases to be true," he penned in 1956. "Cling to it long enough, and...it will turn true again." Indeed, age evidently had its virtues. "I never dared to be a radical when young For fear it would make me conservative when old." Robert Frost died in 1963.




