

Embroidered Pictures To Collect

Like so many handicrafts of the past, creating embroidered pictures is almost a forgotten art. A brief revival happened during the Arts and Crafts decades (1876-1917).

Who has the time to spend weaving delicate threads into intricate and detailed subjects these days? Yet, this was one of the most popular pastimes for

English ladies of the 18th and 19th centuries. These pictures are expensive collector items selling at auction for hundreds of dollars. Prices depend on eye appeal and the skills of the embroiderer.

Copies of famous paintings were translated into fine silk and chenille. Faces, arms, and legs were often painted in. Popular

subjects were taken from the Old-Testament, as well as allegorical figures of the vices and virtues of kings and queens. The fabric pictures were not intended to be hung on the wall as were the original paintings.

The most highly valued paintings are those that combined stitching with painting.

The designed scene was first sketched in watercolors on a plain piece of satin or silk. The faces and hands were untouched; the rest heavily embroidered to create the impression of a relief. Other times

the hands and faces were cut
