Prices were unchanged to lower on yolks, lower on whole, and unchanged on whites when compared to a week earlier. Demand was light to moderate.

Offerings of yolks remained short, supplies of whole egg were usually adequate, and whites were reported as fully sufficient. The undertone was about steady on yolks, barely steady on whole, and unsettled to barely steady on whites. Liquid and frozen eggs (ingredients included) processed under federal inspection in the Eastern region for the week ending April 14, 2001 were 6% less than the previous week and 13% less than a year ago.

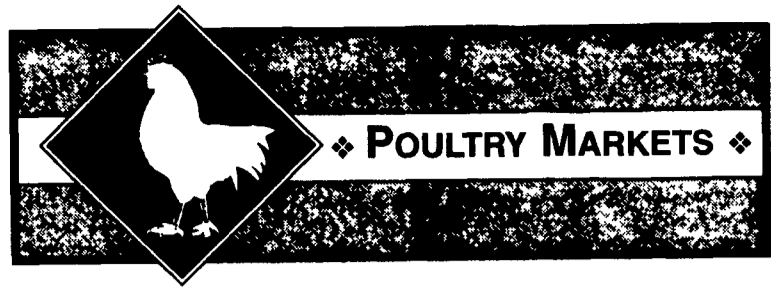
