The first "fancy" chairs as they were called, later "Hitchcock" were made in 1835. They have been reproduced ever since. If yours were made in the 19th century they could sell at auction for over \$2,000 the set. Repros could sell for \$600 the set.

This painted chest, dated 1811 was a wedding present to my mother's grandparents in 1841. It is in all original condition.

It was made in Norway. The lid is hand carved. Can you tell me the value?
