alleviate the intense grief a child bears, but can't articulate. Inner emotions and feelings are often confusing for the child trying to adapt to the state of change.


By providing a nonjudgmental environment for the grief process to occur, adults are able to help the child talk about his or her fears and adjust to the changes in his life.
