A The Forbes Silver Company is one of the original companies that formed the International Silver Co. Forbes was founded in 1894 in Me-

They primarily made silver-plated holloware. To get top dollar a silver plated piece must be in good condition. Yours would have a shop value of \$40 in good condition.

Any idea of what this carved, one piece wood, man's head on a post is and could be worth?

C.D., N. Miami Beach, FL Your 19th century, primitive, wood carved figure is an interesting example of folk art, probably American. Similar pieces have sold at auction for . \$600 and up.

My father bought this Oriental style vase with a lid in England in 1940. What is unusual is there is a padlock attached to a metal

ring round the vase. It is dark blue with pastel color butterflies and flowers. It has no marks. What do you think the origin and value are?

J.A.K.L., Davie, FL Because it has no marks and is Oriental in appearance, I would say it is Chinese Export,

early 19th century, made for the Indian market.

The padlock indicates it was made to hold something of value. At the time tea and tobacco were luxury items. Because it is so unusual I suggest vou contact Becky MacGuire, Chinese export specialist, Christie's, 20 Rockefeller Plaza, New York, NY 10020

I'd love to find out if my mom's chinaware is really antique. The dinner plates show people in 18th century dress in the center. On the back it says "The Harker Pottery Co., quality made in U.S.A. since 1840.

Hand decorated. Warranted 22K.Gold. Old English."

L.M., Miami Lakes, FL While the pottery was established in 1840 your pieces were made in the 1940s. Prices for
