Your waterfowl figurines were probably made in the 1920s.

Their shop value could be around \$125 each.

I would like to know the value of a lorgnette (opera glasses) sterling marked Tiffany, in their original Tiffany cloth cover.

They could sell at auction for \$1,500 or more.

What could I sell my antique bible, published in 1904, Hertel, Jenkins Co.? It is leather bound and has gold leaf on the cover and page edges.

While the contents all bibles are of great value, unfortunately, unless the bible is several hundred years old and with wonderful wood cut engraved illustrations the monetary value is low. A dealer would probably offer you \$25.

This cabinet with the cut glass mirror is one of several pieces my wife, inherited from her German/Polish industrial family in Berlin. The elaborate hardware could be brass. Dove tails are handmade and the pieces are veneered. What is the age and value of the cabinet?

A clue to age would be the hardware. Make a tiny knife scratch. If it shows gold, it could be ormolu (gilt bronze) and 18th century. If silver, 19th century...if the hardware is original.
