

Demand was light to moderate The undertone was mixed but steadier on whites, about steady on whole and steady on yolks Liquid and frozen eggs (ingredients included) processed under federal inspection in the Eastern region for the week ending May 12, 2001 were 4% more than the previous week, but 8%5 less than a year ago
