How Desks Added Beauty To Function

Next time you see someone punching away at an ugly lap top computer, remember portable writing desks were once things of beauty. As lap top desks in the 19th century were treated as items of importance, decorated with brass, silver, tortoise shell and ivory.

Perhaps today's industrial designers will take a hint and add some decorative touches?

Lap tops belong to the decades when letter writing and penmanship were practiced almost as an art form. The lap top opened to the writing flap that was padded

with velvet, felt or leather. There were compartments either on the top or beneath each part of the flap to store stationery and correspondence. Those designed for ladies were elegantly appointed while a simple wood lap top was used by men for both business travel and office. At auction, depending on the quality of decorative elements that can sell between \$150 to \$500.

The first desks made in ancient Egypt and China weren't desks as we know them, but writing boxes; small chests with sloping lids. Not only writing materi-

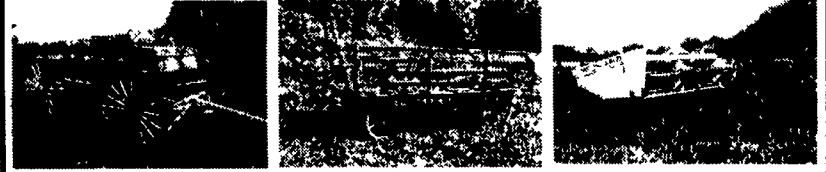
