An 18th century Chester County inlaid spice cabinet brought \$139,000 and a Lancaster Windsor

armchair followed at \$33,000 at a sale held Friday and Saturday at Horst Auction for the collections and estates of John D. Snavely, Leola, the late Sare B. Musselman, Lancaster County,

and the late John W. Haller of Ephrata.

All items were cataloged by C.E. Spohn and included 18th century furniture, pottery, primitives and textiles. There were 360 registered bidders.

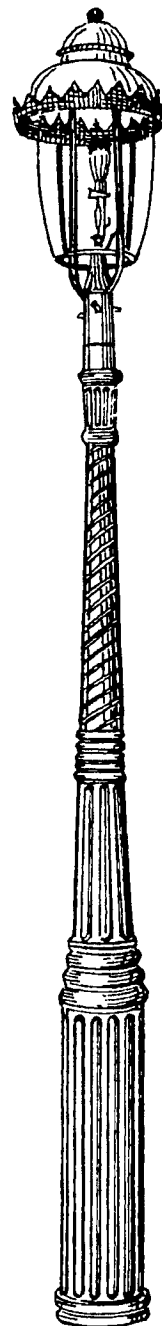
