Weekly Meat Production Under Federal Inspection

WASHINGTON, D C, June 1 - (USDA-NASS) - Total red meat production under federal inspection for the week ending Sat, June 2, was estimated at 757.9 million lb according to the USDA's Marketing Service. This was 14.4% lower than a week ago and 0.4% higher than a year ago. Cumulative meat production for the year to date was 3.0% lower compared to the previous year.

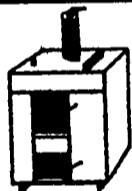

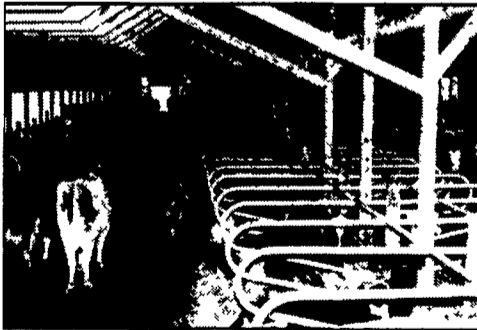
