Prices were unchanged to lower as occasional spot sales were on prevailing market levels. Supplies were limited on yolks, usually adequate on whole, and irregular but improved on white. Demand was light to good with increased orders noted for future deliveries. Trade sentiment was mixed as traders watch further market developments. The overall tone ranged from about steady to steady. Liquid and frozen eggs (ingredients included) processed under federal inspection in the Eastern region for the week ending May 26, 2001 were 5 % less than the previous week, and 9 % less than a year ago. 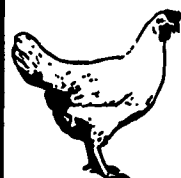
