NATIONAL YOUNG TURKEY PARTS AND BULK MEAT, Frozen, unless specified, cents per lb, delivered first receivers, part and full trucklots, as of June 4:

The trade sentiment was fully steady to firm on skin added mechanicall sep-

arated turkey (mostly) and steady to fully steady on tom drums. Some sellers have noted an increased willingness by buyers, due to the strength of the various red meat trim items, to consider substitution of various red meat ingredients with more competitively priced poultry items resulting in increased domestic activity. Thigh meat trade sentiment was steady to fully steady. Demand was fair to good. Trading on frozen thigh meat was light at higher trending price levels for prompt shipments for export. Thigh meat offerings ranged light to adequate. Domestic trading centered on a light volume of fresh tom breast meat. Some 98% lean scapula traded at 130 and frozen +20% mostly at 20 cents delivered.
