Wheat bids continued to weaken due to harvest progress and lack of new export interest. Corn and soybean bids moved sharply higher on crop concerns due to continued wet, cool weather. Wheat steady to 2 cents lower. Corn 2 to 6 cents higher. Sorghum 6 cents higher. Soybeans 2 to 8 cents higher.

Cool temperatures and heavy rains continue across the Midwest this week. Some crop concerns pushed corn bids higher and crop ratings were lowered in some areas early in the week. Delays in soybean planting offered strength to bids. Lack of fresh export news, limited gains.

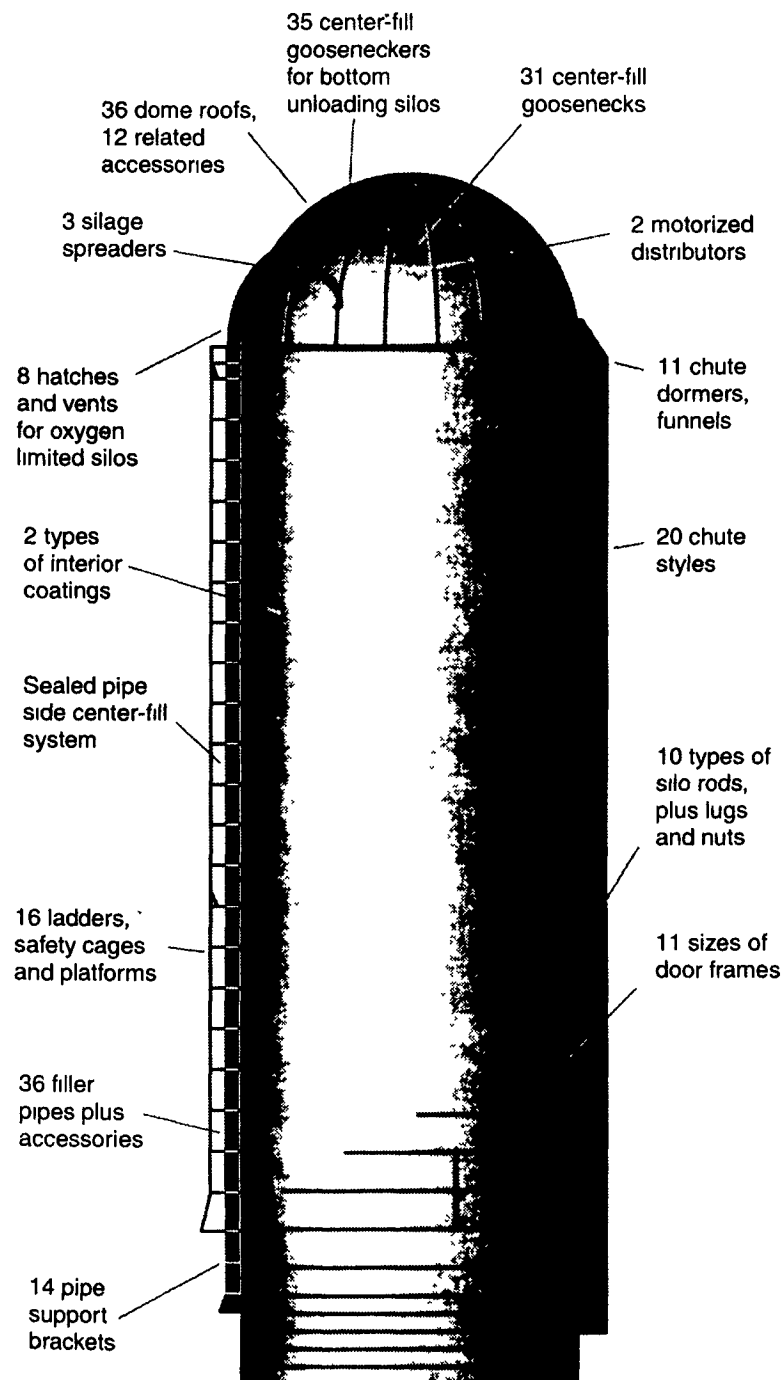
