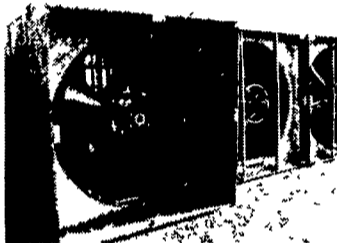

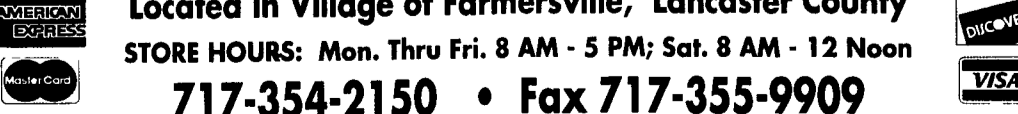

This meeting will be held immediately before the antique tractor pull and show at the Stevens Fire Company

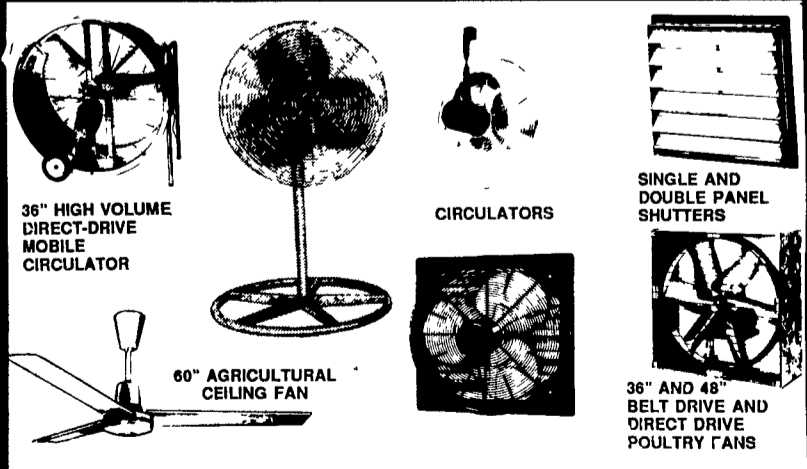
