Demand very good for all classes. Feeder cattle continue to run rather light with limited numbers of steers over 850 lbs and heifers over 750 lbs. Receipts this week 12,101; last week 14,364; last year 8307. Supply consisted of 79 percent yearlings over 600 lbs; 18 percent calves and light yearlings under 600 lbs; 3 percent cows and bulls. Heifers comprised 42 percent of feeder and calf supply.
