SPRINGFIELD, Ill., Fri., June 15 (Ill. Dept. of Ag Market News) — Eastern Cornbelt Direct Sheep Weekly Report (includes lambs sold in IL, IN, OH, MI.) Compared to last week, slaughter lambs over 100 lbs were mostly 10.00 lower. Lambs under 100 lbs were 6-10.00 lower. Demand was light for moderate supplies. Slaughter ewes were steady in a light market test.

Receipts consisted of 65% slaughter lambs and 35% slaughter ewes with an additional 786 head of goats. Total sheep and lambs sales: 1675; last week 1125; last year 1800.


