

Operating Committee Approves Recommended FY2002 Checkoff Budget

DENVER, Colo. — The Beef Promotion Operating Committee has developed a recommended Beef Board budget for fiscal year 2002 of \$45 million.

If approved, the FY2002 budget recommendation would au-

thorize, beginning Oct. 1, 2001, \$23.75 million for promotion, \$4.975 million in research, \$5.5 million in consumer information, \$1.975 million in industry information, \$4.555 million in foreign marketing, \$1.5 million in

producer communications, \$150,000 for evaluation, \$120,000 for program development, and \$2.475 million for administration and USDA oversight.

The full Cattlemen's Beef Board will consider the FY2002

budget recommendation during its summer meeting August 5-9 in Denver. The budget recommendation, if accepted by the full Beef Board, must also be approved by USDA.

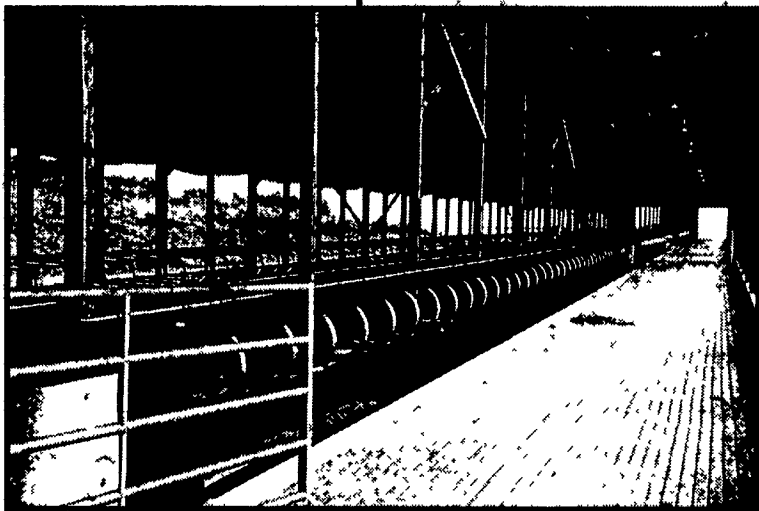
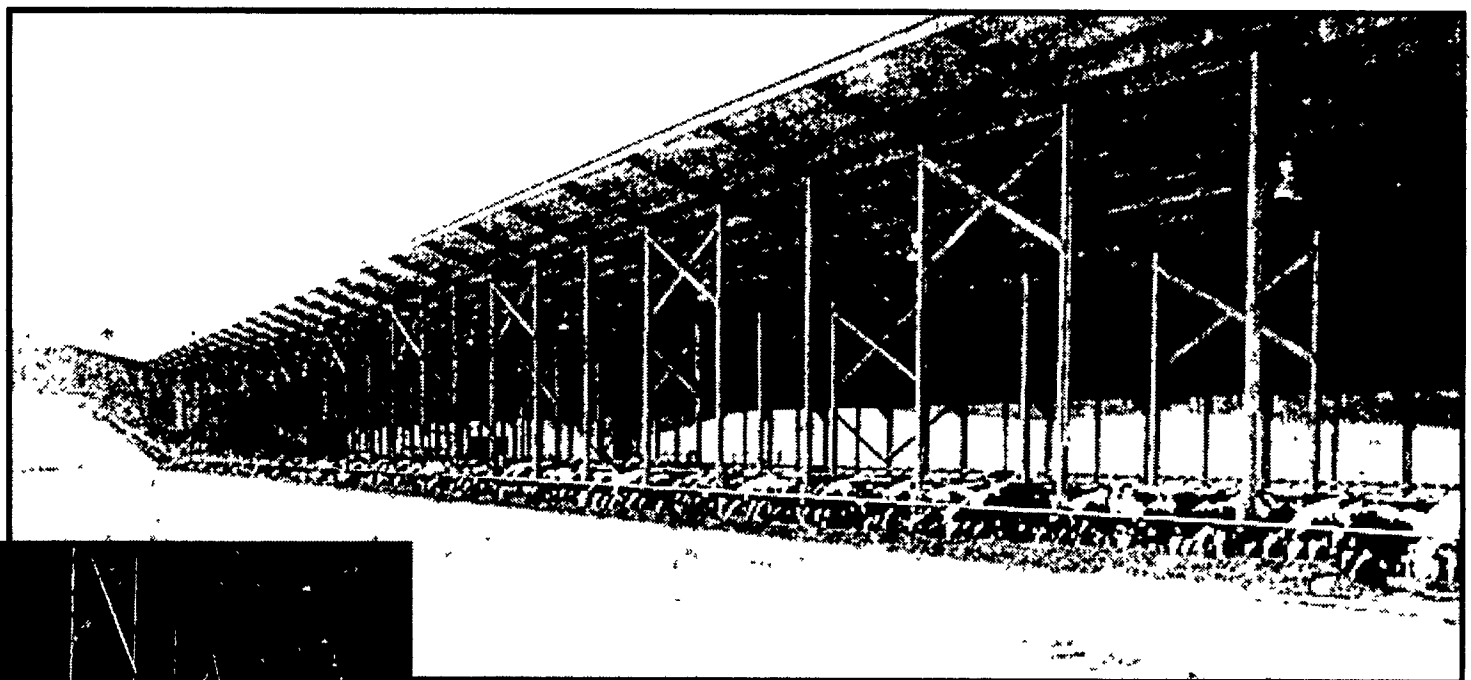
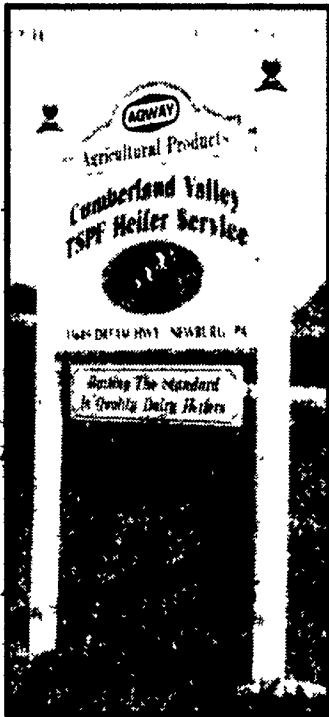

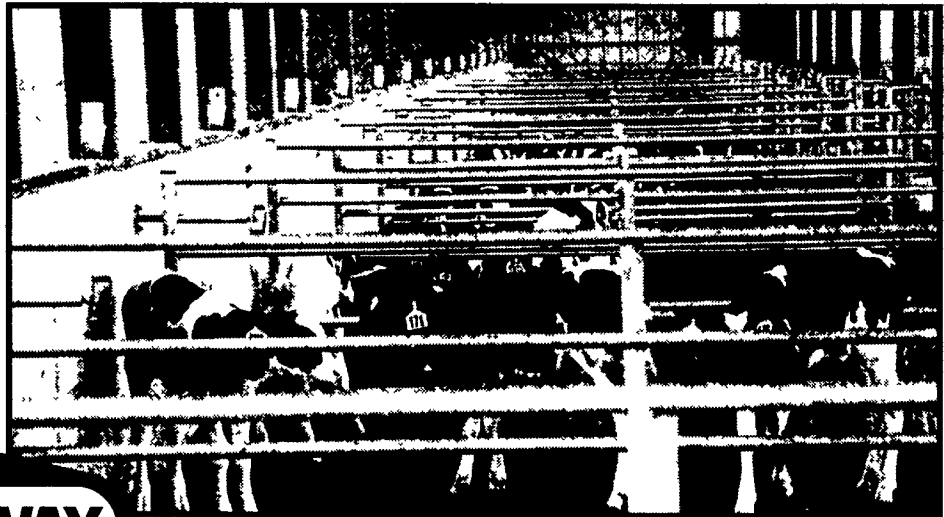
