Oklahoma National Stockyards - Weekly Cattle Summary Compared to last week: Feeder steers and heifers steady though uneven as buyers more discriminating for quality and conditions. Feeder cattle demand good.

Calves steady to 3.00 lower. Calf demand light to moderate as hot dry weather has buyers seeking top quality calves while lesser calves find limited outlets. Bulk of calves are new crops from reputation ranches and these the first of this kind in several weeks.

Receipts this week 13,135; last week 4944; last year 10,983. Supply consisted of 65 percent yearlings over 600 lbs; 30 percent calves and light yearlings under 600 lbs; 5 percent cows and bulls. Heifers

comprised 34 percent of feeder and calf supply. Prices follow with weighted average weight and price in parenthesis.

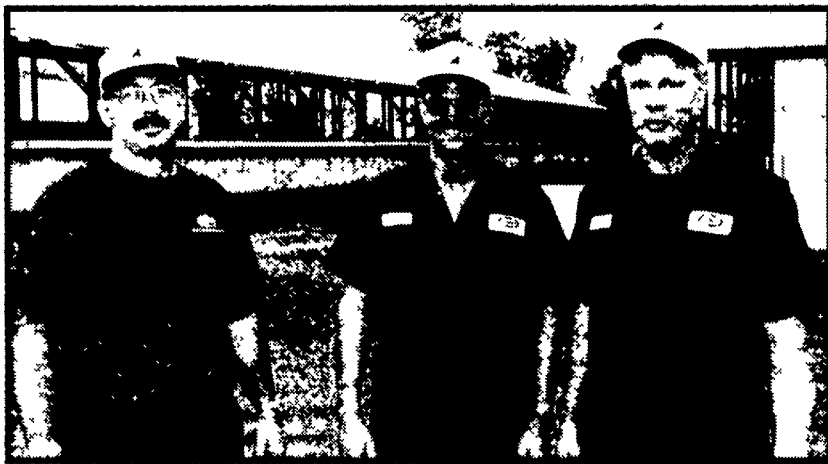
