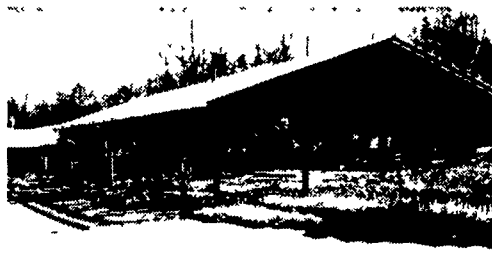

Directions to the Metzler Farm:

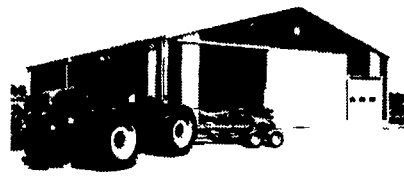
