For Friday, July 20: CATTLE: Compared to last week's closing prices, trading began slow with prices steady. However, by midweek trading became active especially for high dressing Choice steers. Price levels remained steady throughout the week with 1.00-2.00 increase on high dressing steers. Holstein steer prices were generally 1.00-2.00 higher than last week. Offerings of Holstein steers were the heaviest Tuesday with a high percent of fleshy Choice type steers. Supplies of slaughter heifers continue to be light with limited

demand. Price levels were mixed with higher dressing steady to 1.00 lower, and plainer type steady to 1.00 higher. Slaughter cows trended steady throughout the week with flesh boning & breaking types .50-1.00 higher. The thin lean cows were steady to weak. Light and middle weight Yield Grade 1 slaughter bulls were generally 2.00 lower, while Yield Grade 2's were steady. Supply included 42 percent steers, 7 percent heifers, 40 percent cows, 5 percent bulls, with the balance feeders.
