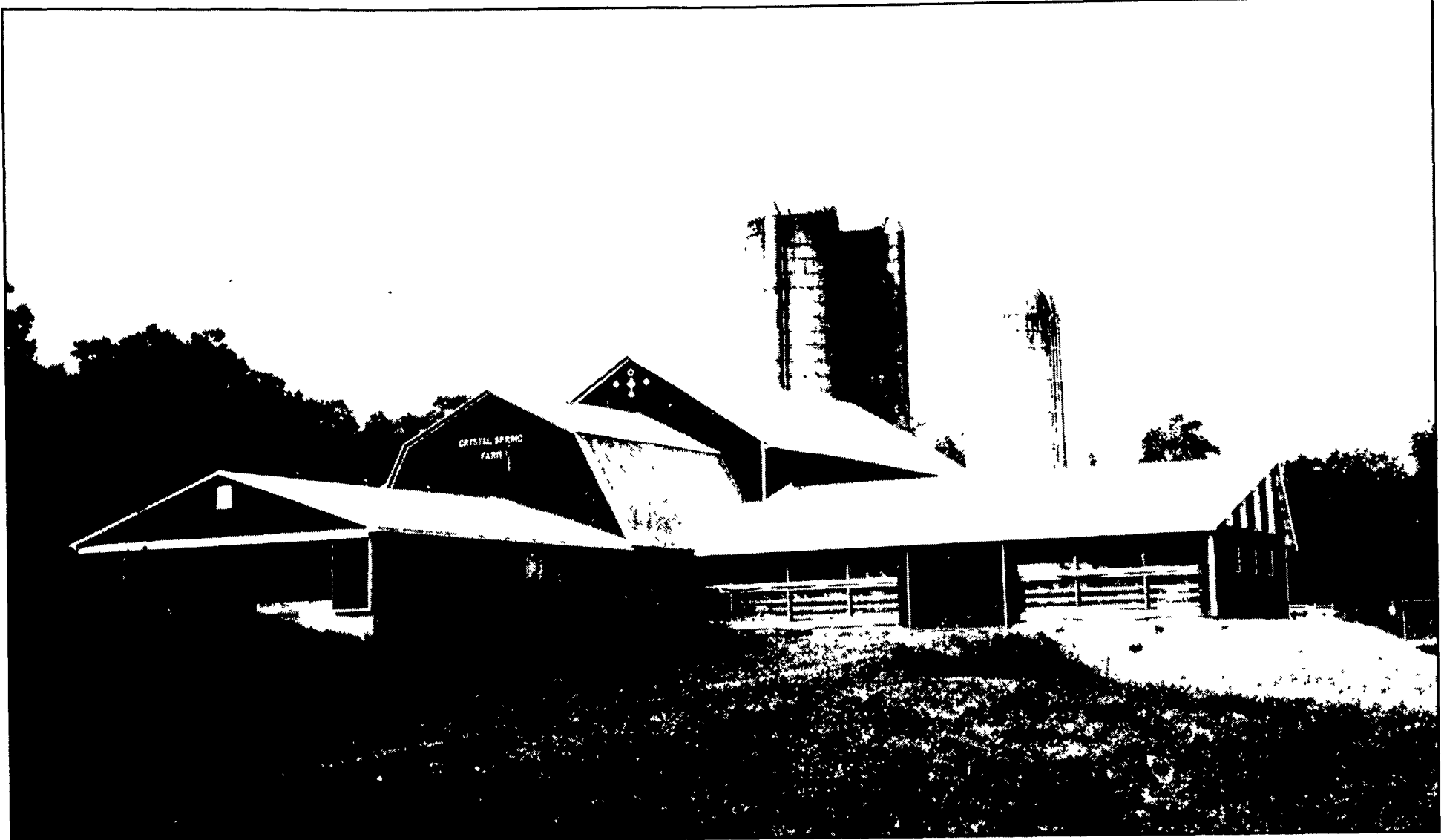

Crystal Spring Farm

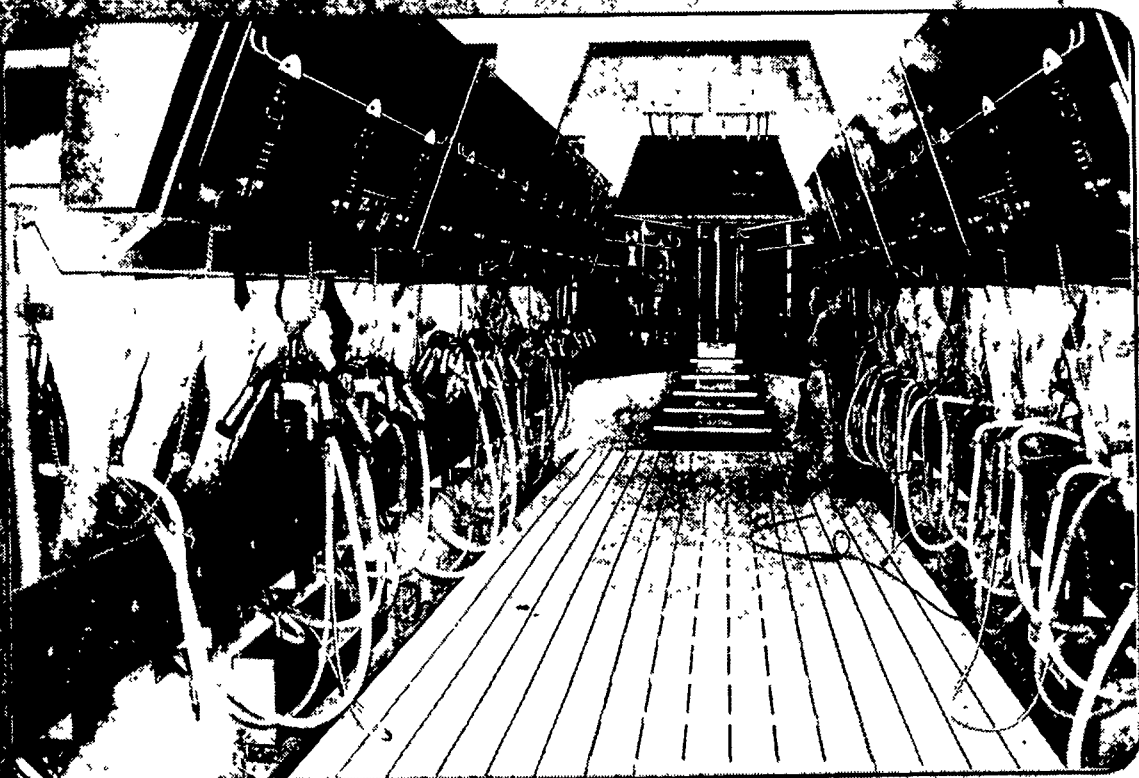
