Can you date and evaluate this 12 piece service of china marked, "Royal Cauldon" "Victoria, England. Est.1774" It has a crown and gold numbers. It was given to me by my mother-in-law who had it many years. The rims are in a multi-color floral pattern.

A.Z. - Bridgewater, NJ

From the description of the markings and the pattern your dinner service was probably made in the 1920s. In mint condition it could sell in a shop for \$900.

What would be the worth of a bone china English castle cup and saucer that was made in Staffordshire, England and has a gold leaf design?

D.M. - Southern, CT

Collectible Staffordshire pieces, 19th century, are earthenware, not bone china. Most likely your cup and saucer was made in the 20th century as a "collector's" piece by one of the many potteries in Staffordshire who were making bone china from the mid 19th century to the present. Similar sets can sell for \$85 to over \$125 in shops.

These four ceramic canisters with blue trim are marked "Germany" on the bottom. Each is marked as follows: tea; oatmeal; sugar and flour. Any

value?

E.F.W. - Staten Island, NY

Ceramic dry food canister sets were popular from the late 19th century into the early 20th. They were made in Germany and Czechoslovakia as sets often containing eight or more containers. The more unusual the design the more expensive the set. A partial set with a plain design, such as yours could sell in a shop for \$200.
