Demand was light to moderate due to a slow down in available empty finishing space. FOB Eastern Cornbelt - Illinois, Indiana, Ohio, Michigan Receipts: 9,500; last week 8,474. Estimated 50-54% Lean Value.

EARLY WEANED PIGS 10 lbs Basis: Lot size under 250: 125 head 35.50; Lot size 250-750: 4,345 head, 28.08-36.22, wtd. avg. 31.23. Total Composite 4,470 head, 28.08-36.22, wtd. avg. 31.35.

FEEDER PIGS, 40 Pounds Basis: Lot size 250-750: 1,900 head 36.00-\$43.00, wtd. avg. 38.21.

FEEDER PIGS, 50 Pounds Basis: Lot size 250-750: 1,330 head, 43.54-50.00, wtd. avg. 45.32; Lot size 750/up: 1,800 head, 41.36. Total Composite: 3,130 head; 41.36-50.00, wtd. avg. 43.04.

FOB prices are quoted on a per head basis "picked up" at the sellers farm in Indiana, Illinois, Ohio, and Michigan; these prices do not include freight.

Most lots of 40-60 weight pigs have a sliding value from the negotiated weight basis which is calculated on the actual average weight of the lot plus or minus .30-.40 cents per pound. Some lots of early weaned pigs are discounted 1.00-10.00 per head on pigs weighing under 10 pounds. Early weaned pigs are under 19 days old. Estimated lean value is projected to base slaughter weights with normal confinement feeding conditions. Vaccination and health program values are not included but health status should be disclosed.
