

Broken Dishes Get A Second Chance

MORGANTOWN (Berks Co.)
— When Susan Dobra, a dealer at The Mill Property Antiques in Morgantown, breaks a dish, it's

not to worry. "I love to rescue things and turn them into something," says the artist, whose mosaic table tops and planters as-

sembled from bits of broken glass and pottery are farm more functional and attractive than the damaged objects she reuses.

When a friend's mother brought her family china, worn and chipped, but still cherished, Dobra went to work carefully breaking it at specific places to save the best of its design. The pieces were then arranged and applied to a table top to be enjoyed as a reworked family heirloom.

Dobra prefers to create her one-of-a-kind mosaic table tops in patterns and pictorials, rather than as random or abstract designs. The yellow bottom of a Fiesta plate with its trademark lettering becomes the daisy center and focal point of a bright burst of flowers atop the base of a cast iron end table.

Sticking with a theme, Dobra often chooses to select all Blue Willow for one piece, while finding damaged Fiesta Ware for another.

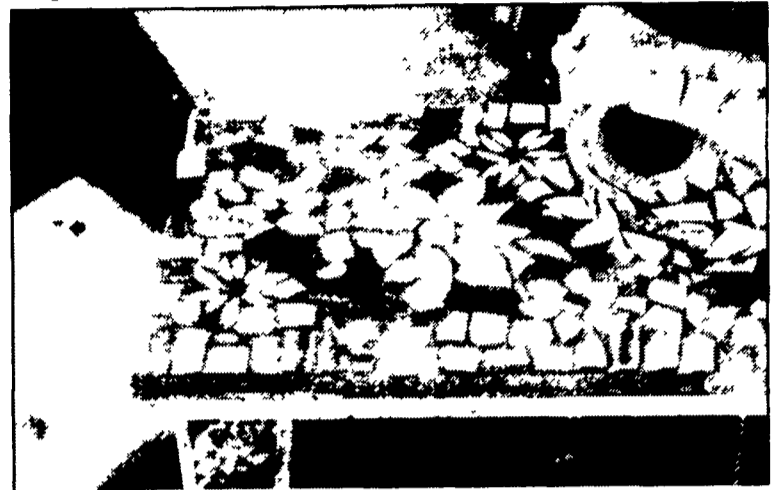
Ordinary metal plant stands with plain or missing tops are given new life with colorful, waterproof tops that can be used indoors, as well as in the garden.

Dealers at The Mill Property are happy to supply her with working materials when accidents happen. "It's nice to know that something I thought was ruined can become art," said one dealer who specializes in fine china, and saves unsold and chipped plates for Dobra's projects.

She sells her pots and tables at The Mill Property Antiques along with other pieces she paints and reworks. Many of the antiques and collectibles she sells feature animals, evidence of her other passion — rescuing dogs and cats. Dobra has a special area at the co-op where she sells animal-re-

lated items, the sales of which benefit a local animal shelter.

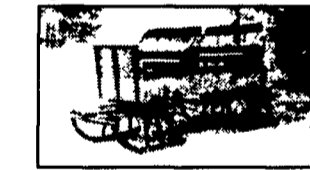

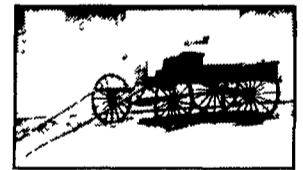
