This was 0.2% lower than a week ago and 3.6% lower than a year ago. Cumulative meat production for the year to date was 2.9% lower compared to the previous year.

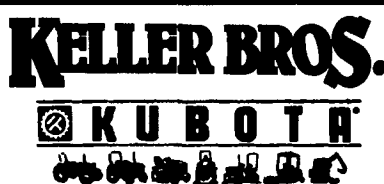

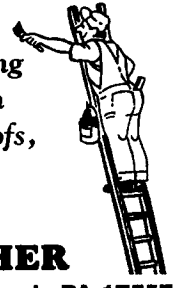
