The festivities will begin at 10 a.m. with the Governor's Proclamation, presented by the commissioner of agriculture and markets, Nathan Rudgers. Following the proclamation, media contestants from Syracuse radio and television stations will be participating in the second annual "Beef Up Your Hero," a sandwich-making contest using fully-cooked beef and yeal products.

Last year, Rick Gary of WIXT Channel 9 took home the "Ultimate Beef Hero" award with his Hormel fully-cooked prime rib and Catelli Bros. veal bacon sandwich. Gary will be returning again this year to face even greater competition in an attempt to defend his title.




